The 2020 Tax Season is Here! Free Tax Preparation is available, Make an appointment now by calling our County office at (609) 886-2784. In Cape May County we are now open and operating on a limited schedule for drop-off only tax filing at the Lower Cape Senior Center and the Howard Stainton Senior Center in Ocean City.

Appointments will be for drop-off tax preparation only. Please remain in your vehicle upon arrival and an intake specialist will be out to collect your documents. Please be sure to protect yourself and others by wearing a face mask.

Cape May County COVID-19 Vaccine Registration

Covid Vaccinations - If you are over 65 and in a high risk group, you should be able to make an appointment to receive a vaccine at one of the following locations. Appointments are limited. All listed vaccination sites may not have open appointments available immediately.

Here's how to get enrolled to receive the vaccine in Cape May County, NJ

New Jersey will roll out COVID-19 vaccines in a phased approach to all adults who live, work, or are being educated in the State. Within 6 months NJ aims to vaccinate 70% of the adult population.

Step 1 - Pre-Register for the Vaccine: <http://COVIDVACCINE.NJ.GOV>

Step 2 - Receive notification e-mail when your appropriate eligibility phase is available.

Step 3 - Schedule your vaccination on-line following the instructions

Step 4 - Bring your confirmation at the scheduled time and location to the vaccination clinic.

Step 5 - Receive vaccination.


